## local rules

- 1. Out of bounds is indicated by white posts, a ball lying outside the perimeter fence is out of bounds.
- 2. The Driving Range is out of bounds.
- 3. Newly planted trees marked with blue posts or protection tubes are no play zones. If such a tree interferes with the players stance or intended swing, the player must take relief under Rule 16-1f.
- 4. Ground under repair marked by blue stakes with green tops is a no play zone . Players must take relief from G.U.R. under Rule 16.1f.
- 5. The area within the yellow penalty area defined by yellow with green stakes on the holes 12, 13, and 14 is a no play zone. When a ball is in the no play zone within the penalty area, the ball must not be played as it lies and relief must be taken from interference by the no play zone:
  - a) under Rule 17.1e., or
  - b) As an extra option, drop a ball in the dropping zone nearest to the estimated point where the original ball last crossed the edge of the penalty area. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3.

Penalty for breach of local Rule: general penalty

## Code of Conduct

1. Players are not allowed to enter the areas within the yellow penalty area defined by yellow with green stakes on the holes 12, 13, and 14.

Penalty for breach of Code of Conduct:

First breach: warning

Second breach: one penalty stroke

Third breach: general penalty

- 1. On leaving the 11th green the bell should be sounded.
- 2. Greenkeepers have standing at all times.
- 3. All posts, signs and other marking objects are immovable obstructions which may not be removed and should be treated according to Rule 16-1b.
